To each proposal candidates were given two choices:
 "support" or "oppose."
 S=Support O=Oppose NR=No Response

O	O*	S	Require abortion clinics to adhere to the same safety standards as other outpatient surgical facilities.
S	NR	O	Add sexual orientation to the list of characteristics that prohibit an employer from discriminating in their employment practices.
O	NR	S	Require public libraries to install Internet filtering technology as a condition for receiving state funds.
O	S*	S	Direct public schools to post founding documents including, but not limited to, the Ten Commandments.
S ²	S*	O	Allow homosexuals to adopt.
S	S*	S	Repeal the estate tax.
O	O*	S	Provide anesthesia for an unborn child undergoing a 2nd or 3rd trimester abortion.
O	O*	S	Eliminate funding for Planned Parenthood.
S	S*	S	Pass legislation calling for a state constitutional amendment defining marriage as the union of one man and one woman.
NR	NR	S	Provide tax credit to corporations and individuals that donate to organizations providing scholarships for students who attend private or non-free public schools.

All candidates were sent an issue survey. Above are selected proposals from that survey and the candidate's answers. If a candidate chose not to complete their survey, voters are given that candidate's voting record and/or public statements whenever available and are marked (*). If their survey answer contradicted their public statements or voting record, their voting record was used and those answers are marked (**).

- 1) Kaine opposes directing schools to post but supports local option.
- 2) Kaine supports homosexual individuals adopting, but opposes homosexual couples adopting.
